

2017 MISSOURI STATE EMPLOYEES CHARITABLE CAMPAIGN FINAL FACT SHEET (02/28/2017)

State employees donated **\$1,109,622**

Total number of donors was **7,850**

State employees have donated over **\$29 million** during the past **32 years**.

Average donation amount was **\$141.35**

This is the **16th year the campaign has exceeded \$1 million**, and the 13th consecutive year the campaign has exceeded \$1 million.

Of the **1,011** charities in the MSECC, **895** received pledges from Missouri state employees.

Department of Social Services employees had their highest pledges in 15 years.
Employees pledged \$121,823

Office of Administration and Judiciary employees had their **highest pledges in the history of the campaign for the second consecutive year**.

Missouri Department of Transportation employees **pledged \$151,849** and ranked **1st** in pledges for the 10th consecutive year.
