

2019 MISSOURI STATE EMPLOYEES CHARITABLE CAMPAIGN
PRELIMINARY FACT SHEET (as of December 11, 2018)

State employees donated **\$1,006,446.00**

Total number of donors was **6,332**

State employees have donated over **\$31 million** during the past **34 years**.

Average donation amount was **\$158.82**

This is the **18th year the campaign has exceeded \$1 million**, and the 15th consecutive year the campaign has exceeded \$1 million.

Of the **877** charities in the MSECC, **784** received pledges from Missouri state employees.

MoDot employees pledged **\$131,412** and ranked **1st** in pledges among state departments.

Office of Administration employees had their **highest pledges in the history of the campaign for the fourth consecutive year at \$120,984**.

MOSERS employees had their highest pledges in the history of the campaign.

Department of Conservation, DESE and Higher Education employees had their highest pledges in 8 years.

Department of Revenue employees had their highest pledges in 5 years.
