

2021 MISSOURI STATE EMPLOYEES CHARITABLE CAMPAIGN FINAL FACT SHEET (as of March 1, 2021)

State employees donated **\$648,514.04**

Total number of donors was **2,987**

State employees have donated more than **\$33 million** during the past **36 years**.

Average donation amount was **\$217.11**

Of the **817** charities in the MSECC, **629** received pledges from Missouri state employees.

MPERS employees had their highest pledges in campaign history. **Employees pledged \$2,448 and had a participating rate of 65%.**

MOSERS employees also beat their previous campaign totals, **pledging \$11,960.**

Department of Mental Health increased their **average employee donation from \$195 to \$321, a 64% increase.**

Of the 2021 pledged donations:
