

2026 MISSOURI STATE EMPLOYEES CHARITABLE CAMPAIGN
PRELIMINARY FACT SHEET (as of December 22, 2025)

State employees donated \$782.937

Total number of donors was 4,464 = 8.81% participation

Average donation amount was \$175

State employees have donated over \$36.8 million during the past 41 years

Of the 479 charities in the MSECC, 426 received pledges from Missouri state team members.

Corrections team members pledged \$112,393 and ranked 1st in pledges.

MoDot team members pledged \$110,622 and ranked 2nd in pledges among state departments.

The MoDOT and Patrol Employees' Retirement System (MPERS) increased their pledges by 32%, had a 55% participation rate, with an average donation amount of \$884/donor.

16 agencies planned a total of 85 fundraisers, raising \$65,760. The Department of Health held the most events, 25 fundraisers and raised \$10,188, MoDot held 17 events, raised \$10,550, with Corrections holding 16 events and raising \$19,485.

Of the 2026 pledged donations:

- \$335, 185 will go to charities in Central Missouri (Region 4)
- \$680,758 will go to charities in Missouri
