

**2026 MISSOURI STATE EMPLOYEES CHARITABLE CAMPAIGN
FACT SHEET (as of 03/03/2026)**

State employees donated \$782,186.04

Total number of donors was 4,434 = 8.75% participation

Average donation amount was \$176.41

State employees have donated over \$36.8 million during the past 41 years

Of the 479 charities in the MSECC, 426 received pledges from Missouri state team members.

Corrections team members pledged \$111,649 and ranked 1st in total pledges

MoDot team members pledged \$110,598 and ranked 2nd in total pledges

The MoDOT and Patrol Employees' Retirement System (MPERS) increased their pledges by 32%, had a 55% participation rate, with an average donation amount of \$620/donor.

16 agencies planned a total of 82 fundraisers, raising \$65,760. The Department of Health held the most events, 25 fundraisers and raised \$10,188, MoDot held 17 events, raised \$10,550, with Corrections holding 16 events and raising \$19,485.

Of the 2026 pledged donations:

- \$335,766 will go to charities in Central Missouri (Region 4)
- \$654,740 will go to charities in Missouri
